The Finance, Procurement and Logistics division of Elections Ontario is seeking a Technical Product Manager who will play a key role in the implementation of Microsoft Dynamics 365 (Finance and Operations) and a Payroll Solution to support Elections Ontario's operational and strategic goals.

What to expect in this role

Reporting to the Manager, Microsoft Dynamics 365 Implementation, you will:

- Lead the product delivery activities for the implementation of MS Dynamics 365, including integration and data migration from existing applications and post Go-Live support.
- Perform need assessments, product definition, product planning, and prioritize customer requirements in alignment with organizational and project objectives.
- Work closely with key stakeholders to understand their needs, gather and analyze business requirements, and convert to software configuration specifications.
- Develop, manage, and maintain backlogs that are clear, concise, and technically sound.
- Lead technical discussions and provide recommendations and expertise to stakeholders throughout the implementation lifecycle.

- Collaborate with vendor's technical resources to configure and validate solutions to ensure EO's technical needs/requirements are met.
- Plan and manage data migration activities, including data transformation, extraction, cleaning, etc.
- Support system integration and end-user testing activities, such as identifying test scenarios and reviewing test results to ensure specifications/requirements and acceptance criteria have been met.
- Manage cross-functional teams, including vendors, to successfully launch the new features and products.
- Review and provide feedback on all project artifacts to ensure Elections Ontario's needs and expectations are met.
- Report on status of assigned activities during the project's SDLC.
- Lead products demonstrations, end user training and documentation.
- Manage client care activities and product support post go-live.

What you need to qualify

- Bachelor's degree in business, e-Commerce, Digital or Information Management. Financial and payroll knowledge is an asset.
- Must have Product Management certification with 5-7 to years of experience leading software development and SaaS solution implementations.
- Demonstrated experience leading implementation of Microsoft Dynamics 365 configurations or similar ERP implementation.
- Experience defining and launching digital products and services, with demonstrated experience utilizing value proposition mapping techniques, Lean principles, and MVP.
- Proven ability to understand business processes and needs from multiple teams and translating them into software configurations.
- Possess strong leadership and project management skills with a track record of balancing multiple priorities, achieving goals and meeting timelines within a fast-paced environment.
- Excellent communication, collaboration and relationship management skills with the ability to communicate at all levels within an organization and managing internal and external stakeholders.

- Practical experience with Waterfall/Agile/Hybrid SDLC methodologies.

- Experience in leading demos and training sessions to ensure smooth adoption of new systems and processes.
- Working knowledge of change management best practices.
